Today **Nine Mile Run Rain Barrel Team** volunteers visited homes on your street to ask you to “keep your rain at home” by installing a rain barrel and to talk to you about **5 Things You Can Do For Nine Mile Run.**

*Participating Nine Mile Run watershed homeowners are eligible to receive one of **500 free rain barrels – complete with free installation** – just for Making the Connection between their Home and our efforts to protect and clean-up Nine Mile Run.*

There is nothing wrong with rain. But every drop picks up pollutants as it runs over lawns and driveways, and then into street drains that flow into Nine Mile Run. We want you to help reduce that flow by catching the rain right off your roof with a rain barrel.

- 68% of Nine Mile Run residents agreed... **rain and roof run-off from their property has a negative effect on... Nine Mile Run.** And...
- 76% of those surveyed agreed... **RainBarrels decrease roof run-off and help prevent basement flooding.**
